Energy Democracy

Energy Dominance

Future-oriented: focused on transition

Nostalgic: focused on reclaiming a mythical past

Community control

Centralized control (oligarchy or corporatocracy)

The public good (fair and equitable employment, new governance institutions, fewer environmental externalities)

Unstable voice of masculine power; totalitarianism; doublespeak

Good for the few (primarily white men of

European descent); bastardized meritocracy

Shared political voice

Adaptive

Fixed

Sustainability, efficiency, conservation

Profligacy, wanton disregard for the commons

Alt-Right Rhetoric Possible Responses

1. Online anonymity

- 1. Emphasize the cowardice of online, anonymous attacks
- 2. Highlight real characters (like "@ironstache"!) and material examples of success
- 3. Start learning about and teaching conservative history, thought, and practice, including alt-right

Possible Responses

- 1. Reclaim sincerity
- 2. Embrace and articulate the "positive projects" of energy democracy, social justice, and diversity
- 3. Know your stuff
- 4. Prepare for threats and attacks

Alt-Right Rhetoric Possible Responses

3. Anti-Cuck

- 1. Acknowledge deeply partisan nature of energy technologies and politics
- 2. Emphasize shared values, such as local control and input
- 3. Clearly and calmly articulate oppositionality: emphasize inclusivity and diversity as positives
- 4. Avoid jargon

4. Identitarian



Possible Responses

- 1. Pay attention to local and regional culture when framing and organizing
- 2. Articulate across resistance sites when it makes sense to do so (e.g., Blockadia)
- 3. Emphasize narratives of progress to counter narratives of nostalgia
- 4. Continue to build on intersectionality and inclusivity
